

CERTIFICATE II IN LIVE PRODUCTION, THEATRE AND EVENTS

COURSE CODE CUE20103

The CUE20103 Certificate II in Live Production, Theatre and Events is based on units of competency selected from the CUE03 Entertainment Training Package.

The qualification provides the foundation of knowledge and skills which will enable participation in the Live Production environment. The course is nationally recognised, and if students have successfully completed all competencies, they are issued with the Certificate from the Queensland Studies Authority at the end of Year 12.

This certificate is designed to introduce individuals to the Theatre industry. Students will work with set design, audio, lighting, visual effects, music and stage management within school and community productions. This course is ideal for students who are excited by the idea of working in theatre.
