

# **SPORTS AWARDS**

---

The sports award system consists of

- 1) Ribbons for places in any level of event in the swimming and athletic carnivals
- 2) Medals for the first, second and third placed age champions in swimming, athletics and cross country
- 3) Certificates for selection in teams for the major sport carnivals
- 4) Gold, Silver and Bronze medallions for the various levels of achievement in a sport when competing within the QSSSSA system
- 5) Selection of Sportsman and Sportswoman of the Year

The criteria for the selection for Sportsman/Sportswoman of the year awards are

The awardee has

- 1) Demonstrated a level of skill performance which is outstanding through involvement in school sport
- 2) Demonstrated a level of skill performance excluding their best sport in a range of sports for the school
- 3) Demonstrated a high level of sportsmanship and co-operation within the school sport
- 4) Demonstrated outstanding leadership and inspiration to others in the school teams.

The award will be selected by a committee of teachers involved with school sport and elected by secret ballot

- 1) Voting will be by assigning a score to each of the criteria for each candidate
- 2) The award does not have to be awarded if there is no one suitable.

## GOLD SILVER AND BRONZE SPORT AWARDS

Speech night sport awards are given on a gold ,silver and bronze award system according to the following criteria:-

### GOLD

A gold award is awarded to a student who:-

- Is selected in a state QSSSSA team to contest the National Championships in a team sport
- Is placed in the top three in an individual event at the State swimming , athletics and cross country championships\*\*
- A Student with a disability who performs to a level above 90% of the national standard for the level of disability.

### SILVER

A silver award is awarded to a student who:-

- Is selected in a QSSSSA regional team to contest the State Championships in a team sport
- Is placed in the top three in an individual event at the Regional swimming, athletics or cross country championships or qualifies for the regional team to contest the state championships.\*\*
- A Student with a disability who performs to a level above 80% of the national standard for the level of disability

### BRONZE

A bronze award is awarded to a student who:-

- Is selected in a QSSSSA zone team to contest the Regional Championships in a team sport
- Wins an event at the Zone swimming and athletics carnivals\*\*
- Is placed First , Second or Third at the Zone cross country Championships\*\*
- A Student with a disability who performs to a level above 70% of the national standard for the level of disability.

\*\* Competitors, in age groups where numbers of competitors are limited by age or other factors, must perform at a level which is commensurate with the requirements of other awardees. The Sportsmaster will be responsible for the determination of these awards. The Sportsmaster will also be responsible for determining the awarding of awards where the level of performance is not recognized under these criteria.
