If you choose to take advantage of the SRS, please complete the Participation Agreement Form and Schedule of Fees Form and return both to the school on Orientation Day, Monday 6 December 2021. A minimum payment of the participation fee of \$95 must be made prior to the commencement of the 2022 school year. Invoices for the 2022 SRS will be generated next week and emailed or posted home. The schools preferred payment method is BPoint. Your child will then be able to collect textbooks in 2022 and will be provided with other resource materials as a part of the scheme.

If you choose not to participate in the scheme, please also complete the Participation Agreement Form and return to the office. A Subject Requirements List is available upon request. Should you not participate in the scheme, you are directly responsible for providing all textbooks and other resources for your child while they are attending school to enable them to engage in the curriculum.

As your student moves into their junior secondary years in 2022 they will require an iPad. To assist you with decisions around iPads I have included a link to our [BYO iPad parent booklet](#). Documentation on how to onboard your iPad to our school network will be sent home toward the end of the term, this will ensure your student is set up and ready for learning on the first day in 2022.

The 2022 Media Consent Form must be filled out and returned as soon as possible.

You will soon receive an email requesting you provide **Third Party Consent** for your child. By completing this survey, you will be giving permission for your child to access the many learning platforms, e-books and textbooks used in their learning at Aspley High. Expect to see this email in your inbox in the next week. It is imperative that you complete this survey as soon as you can so your child we be able to commence using these resources at the start of 2022.
