## How to get to School

### **RIDING**

Enter via gate 1 (not the car park gate) – use the footpath provided

A Bike Cage is located between K Block and Admin, or lock to the bike racks outside G block. Another bike rack is located outside the pool. Make sure it is secured with a bike lock/chain

### **TRAIN**

Travel to Zillmere Station and then walk up Zillmere Road and enter via the gate near the bus shelter

### **WALK**

Enter via gate 1 (not the car park gate) – use the footpath provided

### **BUS**

Buses run to Aspley State High School from various suburbs. Go to

## Uniform

2027 ASP enrollment forms and prices will be emailed home to families in term 4, 2026. The 2025 ASP fees are a one off administration fee of \$50 per child plus an ongoing charge of \$3.30 per hour per child. 2027 ASP fees are not yet confirmed. Afternoon tea will be provided for every student enrolled. Invoices will be emailed home on a weekly basis and will need to be paid within 7 days.

## Homework Club



Homework club is a structured, safe and supportive environment provided for all students of Aspley State High School. Homework club provides help and support in all school subjects and strives to instil good work habits, organisational skills, time management abilities, and a sense of accomplishment in every student. We advocate for a *growth*



*mindset*, and that all students' basic abilities can be developed through dedication and hard work – brains and talent are just the starting point. This view creates a love of learning and a resilience that is essential for great accomplishment. We believe that every student is capable of high achievements with the proper help and the support provided at our school Homework Club.

Homework Club is available in weeks two – ten every term, **Tuesday and Wednesday 2:40 – 4pm** and **Thursday 1:10 – 3pm**, with the exception of holidays and school breaks. Students who finish their work before the end of the session have an opportunity to review classroom learning and engage in higher order thinking activities.

Homework Club is held in the Information Services Centre (ISC) where students sign in on arrival and specify the study areas they will be completing in the session. Junior and Secondary students are allocated appropriate work areas to meet their unique individual needs.

## Extracurricular and Tutorial Opportunities

There are a range of different types of opportunities available to all students in break times as well as before and after school. Each term a new timetable is published on our website.



## School Fees

### **Student Resource Scheme (SRS):**

Aspley SHS operates a Student Resource Scheme (SRS) for all students. The cost of the 2026 SRS is \$275 per student. The SRS is designed solely to benefit students and parents by substantially reducing the financial burden of purchasing expensive resources. It is a non-profit scheme that provides each participant with textbooks, resource books and materials. Our scheme is fully endorsed by the Aspley State High School Parents and Citizens Association. Nearly 100% of parents in the past have elected to join due to the convenience and reduced financial commitment. The 2027 fees will be finalised in Term 4 of 2026 and information will be emailed home.

### **Other 2026 Fees:**

- Instrumental Music Levy SRS \$100 - (All year levels for participating students only)
- Instrumental Music Hire SRS \$100 - (All year levels for participating students only)
- Year 8 and 9 Practical Technology Subject Fee – Food Specialisation (TFD) and Food and Fibre (TFF) \$70. Mandatory fee for students doing these subjects. Invoiced at the beginning of each semester.
- School Magazine (TOORA) (optional): Available for ordering in September and October, priced at approximately \$15.
- Printing Credit (optional): we recommend \$5 per student however printing credit can be topped up at any time for any amount.
- Please note 2027 fees are yet to be confirmed.

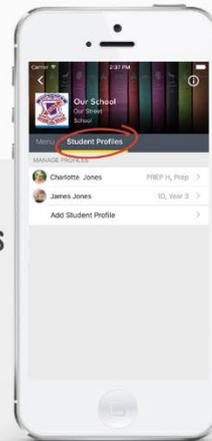

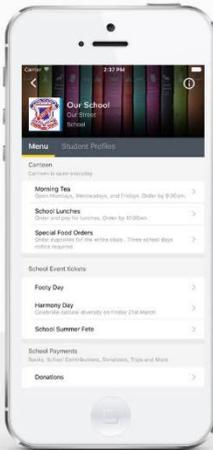

## ATTENDANCE

Students are required to attend school every day. If a student is going to be absent, a parent or carer must notify the school of the reason for the absence either in advance or on the morning of the absence.

To report an absence, you can provide the student's full name, year level, date of absence, reason for absence, your name and your relationship to the student by:

**Phoning:** Call 3863 9260.

**QParents:** Submit the absence via your QParents account.

Students are to make their way directly to and from school. Parents should be aware that no formal supervision of students is provided prior to official school hours.

Absences for which a satisfactory reason has been provided are considered explained absences, and the student's enrolment in compulsory schooling or compulsory participation is viewed as continuous. An absence for which a satisfactory reason has not been provided is considered an unexplained absence. Processes such as cancellation of enrolment warnings for senior students, are implemented when an unexplained absence persists for more than 10 consecutive school days.

While the school implements processes to enforce the compulsory schooling and compulsory participation provisions the student remains enrolled and marked as an unexplained absence. The student remains on the roll unless:

- The student resumes attendance at another school and their enrolment is transferred, or
- The student resumes participation in a different eligible option and their enrolment is transferred.

When a student is absent, or plans to be absent, for more than 10 consecutive school days for any reason, the parent complies with their obligations in respect to compulsory schooling by either:

- Seeking an exemption from their obligation, or
- By negotiating with the principal to make an alteration to a student's educational program; or
- By seeking to arrange a flexible arrangement for the student.

### Absences - Late Arrival

Students who arrive late to school must:

- bring a note or arrange a phone call from a parent/guardian explaining the reason for their lateness
- Year 7 - 9 students report to the school office to get a "Late to Class" pass and Year 10 - 12 students report to the Senior Hub located at C16.
- report to class and produce the "Late to Class" pass to the teacher
- Students who **do not** have parental/guardian permission for lateness may be issued a detention to make up for the amount of time they were not present

### Absences - Text Messaging to Parents

Parents will be notified by a text message each day a student is marked absent from Period 1 without explanation. Parents can reply to the text message from the initial text or phone the absentee line **3863 9260** to advise the school of the student's absentee with student's name, form, date of absence, reason of absence and your relationship to student

### Leaving Before the End of the School Day

Where possible, appointments should be made on Thursday afternoons after 1.30pm. However, in exceptional circumstances where this is not possible, students must present a note from home requesting permission for them to leave. The note should indicate:

- date
- student's form class
- reason for leaving
- time for departure
- signature of a parent/guardian.

This note is to be handed to the Office/Senior Hub before 8.30am, where you will be issued a Leave Request using ID Attend. Students are to show the Leave Request to their teacher at time of departure. Before leaving the school grounds, students are required to sign out at the Office. The Principal will not authorise repeated absences from school on a Tuesday or Wednesday afternoon during school sport.

### **Lunch Pass**

The school does **not** issue lunch passes. Students found leaving school during lunch breaks will be regarded as truant and will receive a consequence from the school Administration.

### **Sickness or Injury**

Students who become ill throughout the school day are to report to the office. Parents will be informed, if they can be contacted. If parent contact cannot be made, the student will sit in student services at the office until parent/guardian contact has been made. If the sickness or injury appears serious, an ambulance will be called. No student is allowed to leave the grounds without permission.

### **Student Transfer Policy**

Parents should advise the school in writing of the reason for leaving. The following items must be returned before any Student Resource Scheme refunds will be made or a transfer form completed:

- Current Student ID card
- All books and resources
- All outstanding amounts finalised

### **Students on Excursion**

At times a student's learning goes beyond the school grounds. In each case parents will be informed via QParents and consent will be required from parents before the student will be permitted to attend the excursion. Students are not permitted to use mobile phones to contact parents while they are on excursions to gain permission to deviate from the excursion. All negotiations will need to be made by parents to the teacher, head of department or school administrators well in advance to the excursion date.

Students are to make their way directly to and from school. Parents should be aware that no formal supervision of students is provided prior to official school hours.

### **Mobile Phone Use**

Students may use their mobile phone up until 8.25am each school day. During class time and break times, students must have their switched off mobile phone in their bag. Mobile phones are not permitted to be used during the day as per our 'Away for the Day' mobile phone policy. Students may use their phone after they have concluded class at the end of the school day.

# DROP OFF, PICK UP AND PARKING ROUTINES FOR ASPLEY STATE HIGH SCHOOL

We are seeking the cooperation of families and students to help make the start and finish of the school day a safer and more orderly experience for all. Zillmere Road is very busy with school and non-school traffic and we must ensure that student pedestrians, drivers and families who are picking up and dropping off, are safe.

Access to the campus in the peak times of morning drop off and afternoon pick up needs to comply with the access points explained below.

Parents are able to use the designated Drop off zone accessed through Gate 1. If you need to park for drop off or pick up, use Car Park 4. Gates 6, 8 and 10 are Staff Car Parks and are not to be used to drop off or pick up students. There are two short-term (max 30 mins) visitor parking bays and a disabled visitor parking bay located near the office through Gate 6. Additional visitor parking is located at Car Park 4. Parents of students with a disability can apply for a permit to drop off/pick up their child/ren from the K block cul-de-sac from Tristan Houghton (Deputy Principal - Inclusion). Parents needing to drop off large or heavy musical instruments can also apply for a permit to use the K block cul-de-sac from Samantha Flohr (Head of Department - The Arts). All permits are to be displayed on the bottom left hand side of the windscreen.

A summary of arrangements is below and a map is on the final page of this booklet.

## DROP AND GO/PICK UP AND GO

- Enter Gate 1 from Zillmere Road and use the drop off loading zone. This is a drop off or pick up loading zone only. Cars are not to be parked here for **more than two minutes**. Parking here impacts on the traffic flow and endangers children's lives. If your child is not waiting ready to be picked up and you are required to park for more than two minutes, you will need to leave the loading zone and re-enter once your child arrives or make use of the car parking available in Carpark 4.
- Enter the K block cul-de-sac if you have an approved permit and it is displayed on your windscreen.

## PARK AND DROP OFF AND PICK UP

- Enter Gate 1 from Zillmere Road and park in Car Park 4 and not the loading zone.

## APPOINTMENTS

- Enter Gate 6 and use visitor parking located near Administration. This parking is for a max 30 minutes.
- Enter Gate 1 and proceed to the right to Car Park 4 where 2 hour parking is available between 9am-2pm.

## NO DROP OFF OR PICK UP

- In Staff Car Parks 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7

## WALKING OR CYCLING TO AND FROM SCHOOL

- Pedestrian gates 5 and 3 near car park 2 are permanently closed as they are unsafe entry points. Students should not be walking through staff car parks when entering or leaving the school.
- Students should always walk on the designated pathways and cross only at the lights and pedestrian crossings. Safe pedestrian access is through Gates 7, 9 and 20.
- Pedestrian gates 2 and 21 near car park 3 are also permanently closed as these are unsafe entry points.

The schools bike enclosure is located directly opposite Gate 20. All students should be accessing the bike enclosure by entering at Gate 20 and safely crossing the road using the Pedestrian Crossing.

# QParents

Accessing and managing your student's information

## What is QParents?

QParents is a free and secure online application that enables Queensland state school parents to access and manage their student's information and complete school-related administrative tasks.

## What information is available in QParents?

Using QParents you can:

- view upcoming events, timetables and report cards
- access and provide digital consent
- view and update attendance details (including future absences)
- view behaviour information
- make payments and view credit balances and payment history
- receive announcements from the school.

## Which schools use QParents?

QParents is available to all Queensland state schools. Please contact your student's school directly to find out if they use QParents.

## How do I register for QParents?

To start using QParents, visit [qparents.qld.edu.au](https://qparents.qld.edu.au) and follow the instructions. Once you have created your account, download the app on your preferred device.

## How do I verify my identity?

When registering for QParents, you will be asked to verify your identity online by providing 100 points of ID from the list below.

## What if I can't verify my identity online?

If you are unable to provide 100 points of ID online, select the 'Not enough ID?' option and visit your student's school to verify your identity. Your student's school can verify your identity by sighting at least one document from the list above, and either one document from Additional Identity Documents List 1 or two documents from List 2.

## Still unable to verify your identity?

Contact your student's school, as they may be able to verify your identity under the 'Known Person/Community Standing' option.

## Where is my personal information stored when I use QParents?

The Department of Education has contracted Microsoft to host the QParents app. Your personal information, which is your username, e-mail and phone number, are stored in Microsoft's secure data centre in Australia. All personal information is protected using the latest encryption techniques, rendering this information unreadable to unauthorised people. For more information, see the [Microsoft Azure Trust Center](#).

## Is my personal information stored when I verify my identity?

**No.** The information you provide during this process is not stored by the department or the contracted identity verification service, GreenID. GreenID uses your information solely to verify that it matches the document provided by the issuer. The department then receives only a confirmation or rejection of your identity from GreenID, not the documents themselves. For more information, view the [QParents privacy statement](#).

## Will you use my data for advertising purposes?

**No.** Queensland Government agencies are not permitted to disclose your information for marketing, advertising or other purposes.

## Where is my student's information sourced from?

Information about your student in QParents is collected through school processes such as enrolment or academic reporting and is recorded in the department's student database, OneSchool.

## How current is the information in QParents?

Information is available in QParents as soon as it has been recorded or updated in OneSchool, or within 24 hours in the case of invoices and payment records. Any information you update in QParents will be available immediately for the school to verify before it is released into OneSchool.

## What if I don't want my student's information in QParents?

Contact your student's school if you want to remove their information from your QParents account.

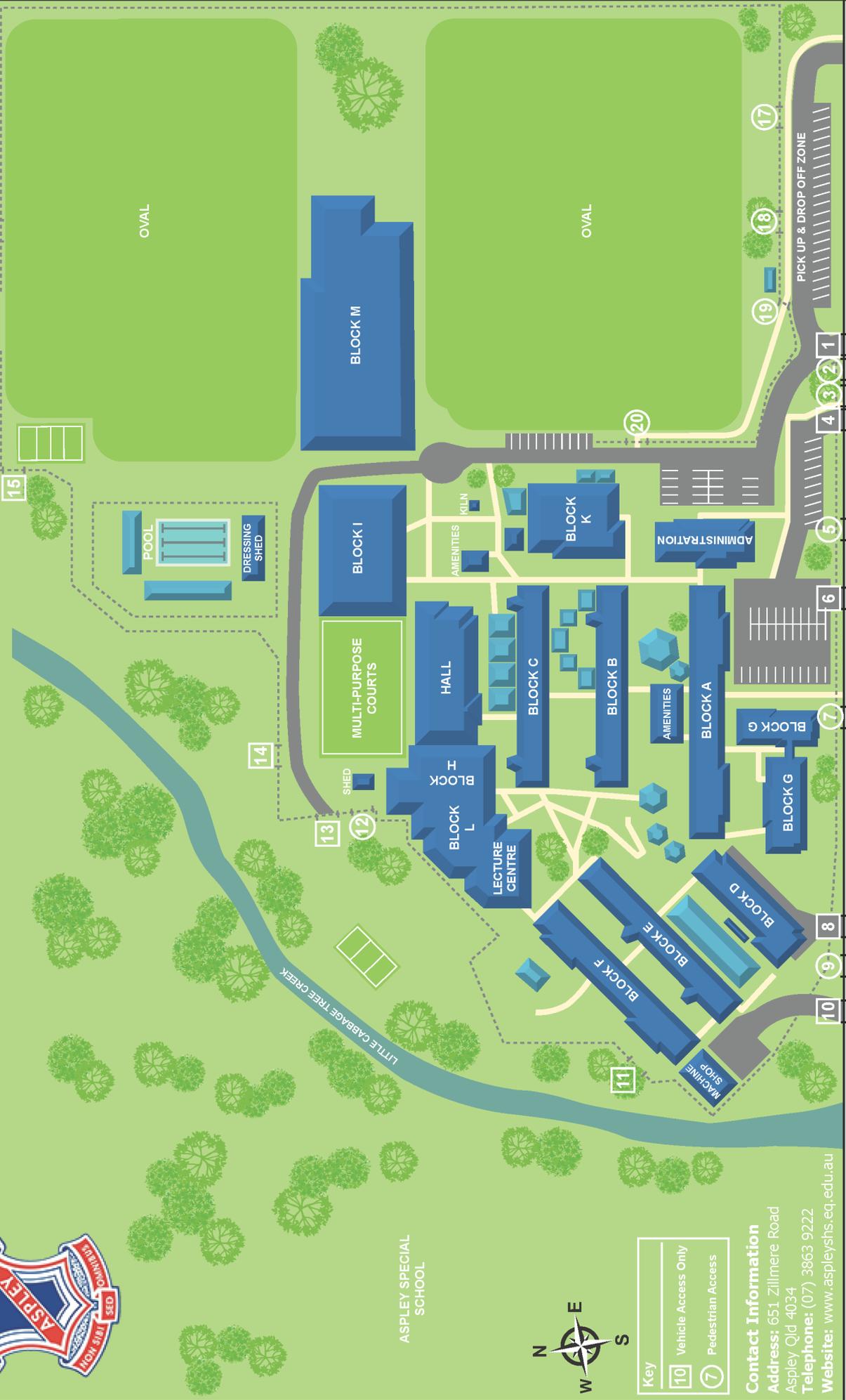
