As a senior student at Aspley High, you have chosen one of these alternative pathways and as a result, may have been allowed to reduce your subject load and have a study lesson on your timetable. With this option that you have chosen comes a responsibility to become an independent learner.

## AN INDEPENDENT LEARNER WHO......

- in consultation with other significant people, sets goals.
- formulates plans to achieve their goals.
- decides on specific actions that lead to achievement of the goals.
- evaluates their actions and adjusts their plans if necessary.
- recognises that self-discipline and good management are essential to life-long learning.

A study line on a student's timetable is designed to provide the student with a suitable environment in which to develop their ability to become effective independent learners.

To help students on their way to becoming an effective independent learner and for the benefit of all who use the centre, we ask that students understand and comply with the following standards:

## STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

Your rights to use the centre, will depend upon acceptance of the following expectations:

- Sign in at the Senior Hub Student Desk through C16.
- Plan to have work to complete and settle quickly on arrival.
- Work with a minimum of noise so as not to disrupt the learning environment of other students.
- You may bring in bags into the Senior Hub, with water bottles allowed. NO other food or drink is permitted.
- As with any other classroom, permission must be gained from the Senior Hub Student Desk (C16) to leave the study area for any purpose.
- If your actions disadvantage other students you may lose the right to a study line.
- The Computer Agreement Policy that you have signed must be followed at all times. There will be consequences for breaking this agreement.
- If you believe that others are compromising your learning, or that other problems exist, it is your responsibility to inform the Senior Hub Student Desk (C16).
