### **BYO Ipad Program 2019 – Student Participation Agreement**

The SPAR-C and TIPS programs at ASHS will require students to bring their own iPad for classroom use. For the BYO iPad program to successfully support teaching and learning in our Year 7 classrooms, it is important for parents/caregivers and students to agree to the following conditions;

#### **Before and during class:**

- The apps published in the 'Aspley State High School App and iBook list' are required and must be purchased and installed ready for use.
- Students are responsible for ensuring their iPads are charged and ready for use in each lesson.
- I will use the iPad only to support my school learning program at Aspley State High School.
- Wait, until directed by the teacher, to use the iPad or open apps.
- Unless advised otherwise, do not communicate with other students through your device during learning time.
- Sharing work via projecting your device through the teacher's laptop, Airserver or AppleTV may only take place after teacher approval.

#### **Communication:**

Collaboration forms a large part of both the SPAR-C and TIPS programs as relating to others and recognising diverse perspectives allows students to develop empathy. To ensure the classroom environment is conducive to learning we ask that:

- respectful communication conventions are used at all times, either on the iPad or when using other communication methods.
- students use **only** their supplied EQ email address when communicating with other students and teachers.
- only use email and other forms of communication, including Bluetooth (Airdrop), during class when directly instructed by a teacher.
- all loss, damages, breakages and theft of the device and accessories are the responsibility of the owner. Parents are encouraged to seek insurance, such as Apple Care, for the device.
- students are to use the device appropriately and for educational purposes only. The iPad is to be used in accordance with the 'Aspley High Agreement of Use' document for Information and Communication Technology.



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### Cyber safety and security:

The safety of our students when working in an online environment is of utmost importance. Web filtering has its benefits; however, these systems are not foolproof and may not block 100% of inappropriate content. We expect students to take responsibility for their use and their device. If you have any concerns, please talk to your child's teacher.

- Whilst at school, only connect to Education Queensland's Managed Internet Service.
- Keep your personal details private. This includes your username, password, address, phone number *and* account details.
- Please do not store, send or upload photos of yourself, other students, teachers or visitors to the school under any circumstances.
- If required, students, parents or caregivers must be willing to surrender passcodes and passwords to the device in the case of an investigation of misconduct.
- Social media (eg. Facebook, AskFM, Instagram, Twitter, SnapChat etc) must not be accessed during class time
- All activities on the school network, including internet history, may be stored, accessed and monitored by authorised EQ staff to determine your compliance with this agreement.
- Hacking, or attempting to hack, the network and other accounts or bypassing network security or filtering are seriously inappropriate uses of ICT equipment and will incur consequences.
- Downloads of large files, videos or images through the school network will affect the use of the network for others. Internet download limits may be put in place by the school.
- The publishing of inappropriate or abusive material about staff, students or the school in any public or school domain including the internet is a breach of the school's behaviour plan for students.
- The viewing, scanning, storing, transmitting, forwarding, printing, playing etc. of inappropriate images, video, audio or email is strictly prohibited. This applies to anything that could cause offence to others and anything that is disruptive to an activity.
- The school name, emblem or uniform will not be used in any way, which would result in a negative impact for the school and its community. Please do not post photos, audio or video of such.
- Please use your iPad lawfully and in accordance with the school's *Internet Agreement Policy* and *Responsible Behaviour Plan*.
