	Use a range of graphic organisers
	Summarise accurately
	Use Inking my Thinking strategy when reading new content
<b>You In preparation for exams</b>	
	Use Class learning review to help with memory
	Start actively studying and reviewing three weeks before exams
	Study in "chunks"
	Use pen and paper to study – actively "draw and Speak" the content
	Minimise distractions – put your phone away
	"test" yourself during study
	Spread your learning out – revise regularly across the term, week and day
	Read your notes out loud
	Use stories to keep your learning in your memory
<b>You during Assignment phase</b>	
	Plan out the deadlines for writing the assignment across the assignment process
	Allocate time each day to attend to the assignment, across the assignment process
	Have the assignment finished three days before it is due
<b>You In Class</b>	
	Write down the learning intention for every lesson
	Books and notes are clear and organised
	Ask questions when you are unclear
	Focus and ignore distractions. Do not speak while the teacher is teaching.
	Take notes while the teacher is giving direct instruction
	Used the ELEVATE advice about note taking and books
<b>At school</b>	
	Go to homework club
	Go to tutorials
	Participate in a study group for subjects
	Submit the maximum number of drafts you can
	Act on the feedback your teachers give you
